- 2. For the convenience of the applicants, the entrance exam will be held on two dates as detailed below. The applicant is expected to choose any one of these entrance test dates and indicate the same in the application form. A candidate can take up the exam only once.
- 3. If an applicant chooses to apply for two courses that have entrance exams, he/she can take both the exams on the same day. These candidates must report to the helpdesk an hour before the commencement of the exam.
- 4. A list of candidates provisionally selected for interview will be published on the website by evening 7 pm on the day of the entrance test. The interview for such candidates will be held on the following day (Monday). Candidates are required to come prepared with all necessary documents, entire fees for the course and also plan your travel accordingly.
- 5. The candidates must check the classroom number/seat allotment list displayed on the notice board on the day of the entrance exam and be at your seats at least 15 minutes before the commencement of the exam.
- 6. No candidate is allowed to enter the exam hall after 15 minutes of the commencement of the start of the exam. The candidate can leave the hall after 30 min of commencement of exam.
- 7. No cell phone, smart watches, book, any form of print material or electronic gadgets, calculators will be allowed to the exam hall. Any form of malpractice reported will be subject to disqualification of the candidate from the admission process.
- 8. Parking is provided on the ground and entry will be from gate no 1 on Langford Road
