The option to select the open electives will be available on the student (Linways) portal.

II semesters from 18th January,2023 6 pm onwards and will be kept open till the 20th January 2023.

IV semesters from 19th January,2023 6 pm onwards and will be kept open till the 21st January 2023

Please note that there will be a cap on the number of students opting for a particular course. The seats will be available on a first-come first serve basis. Students are advised to prioritize their top three Open Elective Options and keep them handy before applying.

Course material will be available on the student portal from 23rd January, 2023 onwards. For all practical purposes, 23<sup>rd</sup> January, 2023 will be considered the first day of starting the Open elective courses. Students are expected to meet the deadlines to submit assignments, quizzes or other activities (if any) as stipulated by the respective course teachers.

All teachers offering open elective courses are available on the University campus in their respective departments. Students are encouraged to meet in person to clear any doubts or clarifications that they may have regarding the topics discussed in the videos.
