#### 2.Initial Selection:

First Level Selection Applications will be evaluated using a combination of aptitude test score, academic and personal information.

#### 4. Announcement:

Announcement of Scholars – Up to 5,000 scholars. All candidates will be evaluated on the basis of merit cum means. Selection of Scholars will be announced in March 2023.

### Eligibility Criteria:

Students who have passed std. 12 th with minimum 60% marks and enrolled in 1 st year full-time undergraduate degree in any stream

You must fulfil the following eligibility criteria in order to apply:

- Be a resident Indian citizen
- Passed Standard 12th with minimum 60% and is attending a full-time undergraduate degree programme In
- Students having House Hold income < Rs. 15 Lakhs (preference given to < Rs. 2.5 Lakhs)
